## Regional Alpine Squad Selection 2010

### The Basis for selection of LSERSA Regional Alpine Squad

#### **1. Selection Panel:**

- a) The selection panel should be comprised of two or three persons nominated by the committee to carry out the task.
- b) The LSERSA chairman and regional coach should have final say.

#### **2. Selection Criteria for Regional Squad Status:**

- a) A skier must be a registered member of SSE and belong to a club whose first registered region is LSERSA, as determined by the lists provided by SSE.
- b) All skiers must be actively participating in regional or national races.
- c) If a skier belongs to more than one club affiliated to different regions the skier may only compete for the first listed club.
- d) Initial selection should be based on a national seed points with a cut-off agreed by the regional coach. Since the normal minimum age would be CH1 a coaches report or regional points may be used for selection.
- e) The older athletes should be regularly competing at national or regional level.

#### **3. Purpose of Squad:**

- a) To provide athletes with a status or target to aim for regional level.
- b) To provide support for sponsorship / grants from outside agencies.
- c) To enable our sponsors, if they wish, to provide additional prizes or discounts.

**NB: This is not selection to provide additional coaching or entry to particular races when representing the region.**
