EQUIPMENT RULES

All Racers are asked to make sure that they are aware of the latest FIS Equipment Rulings. Those rules can be downloaded from the FIS website as well as from www.britski.org. Usually, the Precisions for the Northern Hemisphere are published each year in November.

Children and Minis must wear CRASH HELMETS for Giant Slalom.

ACCEPTANCE

To participate in the BARSC Championships at *Junior or Children* level, British competitors must be registered with BASS. The current registration number applicable as at 1st December 2004 must be shown on the Entry Form. Seeding will be based on FIS points/BASS points.

PLEASE NOTE: All **Junior** Racers, who opt not to apply for a full or restricted FIS licence for the 2004/2005 season must apply for a ghost FIS licence a minimum of 3 weeks prior to any event. The application form can be

downloaded from the Snowsport GB website. Junior Racers, without a valid FIS Number cannot be accepted into any FIS competition.

Competitors in the **Minis** categories must either have signed the Snowsport GB Athlete Declaration or be registered with their Home Nation Governing Body.

The acceptance of entries is at the discretion of the Organising Committee who reserves the right to give priority to members of BARSC Clubs.

All competitors MUST have a current INSURANCE Policy that permits them to ski race. The Race Organisation will require proof of this Policy.

An acceptance list (subject to FIS regulations at the event) will be distributed by Thursday, 09 December 2004 to all applicants who have enclosed a stamped, self-addressed envelope with their entry form. The acceptance list will also be published on www.barsc.net or www.britski.org

(BARSC Clubs at the moment are: AVSC, BSA, DHO, Dragons, Kandahar, Kings Ski Club, Ladies Ski Club, Sandown Park Ski Club, Slalom Plus, Snow Sports, Telford Ski Club and The Snow Club)

ENTRIES

All British Entries must be made on the enclosed race entry form – one per competitor – and be accompanied by the Race Entry Fee of £ 30.00 per competitor, per race for members of BARSC Clubs and £ 35.00 per competitor, per race for NON-BARSC Club members.

Race entry fee for the MINIS is £ 15.00 per competitor, per race for BARSC Clubs members and £ 20.00 per competitor, per race for NON-BARSC Club members.

Cheques must be made payable to BARSC.

Entries should be sent to the Championships Secretary: Ros Humphrey, Berries, 8 Cambridge Way, Uckfield, East Sussex, TN22 2AD.

Closing date for UK entries will be Friday, 03 December 2004.

Any *Late Entry* will incur a penalty of £ 10.00 per competitor. No guarantees or promises can be made regarding the chances of a late acceptance; competitors are therefore warned their presence in the resort will not necessarily gain them entry into the races.

Resort Entries should be handed into the Race Office between 15.00h and 16.00h on Saturday, 01 January 2005 (in Alpbach) and will be considered by the Organising Committee.

Non-British Entries: The appropriate National Ski Federation must submit entries for the FIS events on the appropriate FIS entry forms.

Non-British Entries for the Children and Minis Races should also be submitted to the Championships Secretary by 03 December 2004.

Please note:

Due to the enormous cost in organising these Championship Races, there will be no refund of race entry fee made available after your race entry has been accepted even if one or more races are cancelled.

The 'Galtenberg' ski area is in Inneralpbach. Maps of the skiing area will be available from the Race Office in Alpbach.
