Organisation

The championships are organised by Wycombe Summit Ski and Snowboard Centre on behalf of the Snowsport England. The European Championships will be considered for seeding.

Entry Criteria

The Championships will consist of a special slalom in the morning (run in accordance with Snowsport England Grand Prix rules, i.e. 2 courses), followed by a team parallel slalom. The team parallel slalom will be for children, juniors, seniors and masters.

Entry is open to foreign racers and registered racers of the home nations in the following categories: Children I, Children II, Junior I, Junior II, Seniors and Masters. Home nation racers with more than 250 seed points will not be accepted into the race

The minis race will a separate race consisting of a special slalom run in accordance with Snowsport England Grand Prix rules, i.e. 2 courses), and be sited on the side slope

The Mini's race is open to registered racers born in 1995-1998.

Course Inspection

It is clear that many racers consider that it is permissible to ski the gates during course inspection. The rules of ski racing specifically forbid that practice (ICR 804.1 and SSE RM 252.6.4). Similarly, it is not permissible to ski at speed on a slope that is closed for course inspection (safety issue). Juries have been instructed to monitor behavior during course inspection and to reinforce the Course Inspection rules.'

The course must be inspected wearing skis, and bibs numbers must be visible throughout course inspection.

Race trainers/coaches may accompany their racers and do not now need to wear skis. Course inspection may start from any point on the course.

Every attempt will be made to keep to the above schedule. The organisers reserve the right to amend the programme as necessary.

Race Rules

For this Race whilst skiing through the poles all competitors and forerunners must wear head protection complying with BS EN1385 or equivalent.

The Start Referee has the right to refuse a racer starting if the racer does not appear on time. The Start Referee will be instructed to work to FIS 613.6.

To reduce the risk of injury racers will be required to wear gloves, long trousers and a long sleeved garment, which also covers the midriff, at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and during the race. Racing in crop tops is not acceptable

If time allows, racers who are DISQ or DNF in the 1st run will be given a second run, however their times will not be recorded on the results.

The parallel slalom relays will be run in accordance with the Snowsport England race manual – Paragraphs 1100 – 1119.8 and will consist of one run per round with the final being decided in the best of three runs. Any team having a bye in the first round, will be allowed one training run down one course only, before the competition starts - therefore no byes will be skied other than in the first round. No competitor may race for more than one team in a given day.

Team Parallel Slalom - International Championships

A team will consist of six racers from the Children, Junior, Senior and Masters categories, at least two of whom must be from the opposite gender. Each team will be seeded from the results of the day's special slalom. A single entry will be accepted from each of the Home Nations and other national teams present to a maximum of 16. In the event of fewer than 8 entries being received, a second entry may be accepted from each nation to a maximum of 8 teams.

A substitution may be accepted by the jury on the basis of injury, or from an overseas team being unable to achieve the minimum number of team members. Any substitution must be agreed in advance with the Jury

Prize giving will take place on Sunday at approximately 17.30 hours. The winners will be expected to show due to courtesy to the organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason could lose claim to their award.

Acceptance

Minutes of the first jury meeting held on Saturday 2nd July 2005. Valid entries were received from 138 racers (1 Girl, 7 Boys, 44 Females and 86 Males. All valid entries were accepted.

As the race is under subscribed at this time the jury decided to produce an acceptance list, the start list will be drawn using Seed List 2005.3 at the next jury meeting and displayed on the official notice board on the morning of the race.

Entries from racers with a note by their name on the enclosed start list were provisionally accepted, and must see the Race Secretary on race day to validate their entry prior to collecting their bib. Notes are as follows:

- S requires the entry form to be signed.
- P requires payment / payment adjustment of £15.00 race entry fee.
- R requires proof of registration

Late entries

The jury will consider late entries (up to a maximum of 200 racers) received by 5 pm Wednesday 13th July 2005. Late entries will also incur a £5 additional payment making the total entry fee £20.

Protests and late entry acceptance confirmation

The Race Secretary must receive protests against non-acceptance of entries in writing by 5 pm Wednesday 13th July 2005. Results of protests, and confirmation of acceptance of late entries may be obtained by phoning the Race Secretary Sally Woods on 01634 362174 between 8pm and 9pm on Thursday 14th July 2005.

Race Office

The race office will be at the race secretary's address until the evening of 15th July 2005 and will be located at Wycombe Summit Ski Centre from 7.30 am 16th July 2005.

Notice Board

The official race notice board will be located on the balcony outside the Restaurant at the Ski Centre.

Commentator sheets and race bibs

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the final run, and failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib.

Referee's Report Protests

Referee's Report protests must be made in writing on official forms, which will be available at the race office. These must be completed and handed in within the set time limit, and accompanied by a fee of £25.

Photography

Racers who do not wish to be photographed by any accredited photographer must notify the race secretary in writing by the end of racer registration on the day of the race.

Open Practice

Wycombe Summit Ski Centre will be open for open practice from 10.00am to 22.00 hours on Friday 15th July and until 18.00 hours on Saturday 16th July 2005. Prices are £11.00 for the session.

Regulations

Racers are reminded of the following:

1. Ski Poles with a tip diameter of less than 15mm must be fitted with suitable tip protectors to increase the tip diameter to 15 mm.
2. Bad Language – TD's have been instructed to apply the unsportsmanlike behavior rule to any racer using bad language. This will result in sanctions ultimately leading to bans for repeated offenders.
3. Ski Binding Heights, Children 50mm Max, Junior /Seniors 55mm Max.
4. For this Race whilst skiing through the poles all competitors and forerunners must wear head protection complying with BS EN1385 or equivalent.

5. Start Licenses may be checked.
6. All racers are advised to read the revised ROTP race manual - available at www.rotp.snowsportengland.org.uk
7. Dope testing may take place at this event.

Refunds

Following acceptance into the race, refunds of £10 will only be given to racers on production of a medical certificate.

Directions to Slope

From Junction 3 of the M40

Via London - from the motorway slip road proceed to the 'Tesco' roundabout. Take the first exit on the left, signposted to Maidenhead and Flackwell Heath. At the next roundabout turn right (underneath motorway) signposted towards Flackwell Heath. At the next roundabout go straight on and immediately left into Kingsmead Road. Follow road for about 1 mile. As the road bears right around a sharp corner, turn left into Abbey Barn Lane. Continue up the hill and Wycombe Summit is on the right.

From Junction 4 of the M40

Via London or Oxford - take the slip road onto the large 'Cressex' roundabout. Take the A404 signposted to High Wycombe. As you leave the roundabout you will join a dual carriageway. Continue through traffic lights and follow High Wycombe signs around the next roundabout. As the road descends down towards High Wycombe town centre get into the right hand lane at the traffic lights. Turn right across the hill signposted Flackwell Heath and RAF Daws Hill. Follow this road (watch out for the speed camera) over the motorway bridge and after about 2 miles turn left into Abbey Barn Lane, signposted with brown tourist signs. Continue down this road, under the motorway, and Wycombe Summit is on the left.
