High Wycombe, Bucks HP10 9QQ

**Race Date:** Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2005

### **Race Bulletin No. 1 and Acceptance List**

#### **Organisation**

The event is being organised by Wycombe Ski Club on behalf of Snowsport England.

#### **Entry Criteria**

The Club National event is a special slalom of 3 runs down the same course, and is open to registered racers in the following categories: Children I, Children II, Junior I, Junior II, Senior and Masters. Racers with no seed points are given priority over those with seed points. The Mini's race follows the same format, and is open to registered racers born in 1995-1998. If the race entry does not reach 180 registered racers then non registered racers may enter the race provided an extra fee of £5.00 is paid to cover the cost of insurance i.e. total entry cost £20.00.

Please note that racers are only allowed to enter one Snowsport England race as non-registered

Members of non Home Nation teams participating in the Championship weekend will be accepted into the race but will race 'Hors Concours'.

Every attempt will be made to keep to the stated times, but the organisers reserve the right to change the times if necessary. Please check the race notice board on arrival and listen out for announcements over the PA system.

## Race Rules

The race will be run under FIS rules as varied by Snowsport England. The last run will be in reverse time order based on the best time from the first two runs. The result will be based on the best time from the first two runs plus the time from the third.

For this Race whilst skiing through the poles all competitors and forerunners must wear head protection complying with BS EN1385 or equivalent.

The Start Referee has the right to refuse a racer starting if the racer does not appear on time. The Start Referee will be instructed to work to FIS 613.6.

To reduce the risk of injury racers will be required to wear gloves, long trousers and a long sleeved garment, which also covers the midriff, at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and during the race. Racing in crop tops is not acceptable

## Course Inspection

It is clear that many racers consider that it is permissible to ski the gates during course inspection. The rules of ski racing specifically forbid that practice (ICR 804.1 and SSE RM 252.6.4). Similarly, it is not permissible to ski at speed on a slope that is closed for course inspection (safety issue). Juries have been instructed to monitor behavior during course inspection and to reinforce the Course Inspection rules.'

The course must be inspected wearing skis, and bibs numbers must be visible throughout course inspection.

Race trainers/coaches may accompany their racers and do not now need to wear skis. Course inspection may start from any point on the course.

Masters racers please note that they are not eligible for prizes in the senior age group. For all Snowsport England races seniors and masters are designated as separate age groups.

The winners will be expected to show due courtesy to the organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason lose their claim to an award.

Racers Racing 'Hors Concours' will not be eligible for Club National Awards.

## **Acceptance**

Minutes of the first jury meeting held on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2005. Valid entries were received from 159 racers ( 4 Girls, 15 Boys, 44 Females and 96 Males. All valid entries were accepted.

As the race is under subscribed at this time the jury decided to produce an acceptance list, the start list will be drawn using Seed List 2005.3 at the next jury meeting and displayed on the official notice board on the morning of the race.

Entries from racers with a note by their name on the enclosed start list were provisionally accepted, and must see the Race Secretary on race day to validate their entry prior to collecting their bib. Notes are as follows:

- S requires the entry form to be signed.
- P requires payment / payment adjustment of £15.00 race entry fee.
- R requires proof of registration

## **Late entries**

The jury will consider late entries (up to a maximum of 180 racers) received by 5 pm Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2005. Late entries will also incur a £5 additional payment making the total entry fee £20

## **Protests, and late entry acceptance confirmation**

The Race Secretary must receive protests against non-acceptance of entries in writing by 5 pm Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2005. ## **Race Office**

The race office will be at the race secretary's address until the evening of 15<sup>th</sup> July 2005 and will be located at Wycombe Summit Ski Centre from 7.30 am 16<sup>th</sup> July 2005

## **Notice Board**

The official race notice board will be located on the balcony outside the Restaurant at the Ski Centre.

## **Commentator sheets and race bibs**

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the final run, and failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib.

## **Referee's Report Protests**

Referee's Report protests must be made in writing on official forms, which will be available at the race office. These must be completed and handed in within the set time limit, and accompanied by a fee of £25.

## **Photography**

Racers who do not wish to be photographed by any accredited photographer must notify the race secretary in writing by the end of racer registration on the day of the race

## **Open Practice**

Open practice will be available at Wycombe Summit Ski Centre on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2005 from 6pm to 10pm for a cost of £11.00 for the session.

## **First Aid**

Wycombe Summit Ski Centre Staff will supply First Aid.

## **Regulations**

Racers are reminded of the following:

1. Ski Poles with a tip diameter of less than 15mm must be fitted with suitable tip protectors to increase the tip diameter to 15 mm.
2. Bad Language – TD's have been instructed to apply the unsportsmanlike behavior rule to any racer using bad language. This will result in sanctions ultimately leading to bans for repeated offenders.
3. Ski Binding Heights, Children 50mm Max, Junior / seniors 55mm Max.
4. For this Race whilst skiing through the poles all competitors and forerunners must wear head protection complying with BS EN1385 or equivalent.
5. Start Licenses may be checked.
6. All racers are advised to read the revised ROTP race manual - available at [www.rotp.snowsportengland.org.uk](http://www.rotp.snowsportengland.org.uk)
7. Dope testing may take place at this event.

## **Refunds**

Following acceptance into the race, refunds of £10 will only be given to racers on production of a medical certificate.

## **Directions to Slope**

### **From Junction 3 of the M40**

**Via London** - from the motorway slip road proceed to the 'Tesco' roundabout. Take the first exit on the left, signposted to Maidenhead and Flackwell Heath. At the next roundabout turn right (underneath motorway) signposted towards Flackwell Heath. At the next roundabout go straight on and immediately left into Kingsmead Road. Follow road for about 1 mile. As the road bears right around a sharp corner, turn left into Abbey Barn Lane. Continue up the hill and Wycombe Summit is on the right.

### **From Junction 4 of the M40**

**Via London or Oxford** - take the slip road onto the large 'Cressex' roundabout. Take the A404 signposted to High Wycombe. As you leave the roundabout you will join a dual carriageway. Continue through traffic lights and follow High Wycombe signs around the next roundabout. As the road descends down towards High Wycombe town centre get into the right hand lane at the traffic lights. Turn right across the hill signposted Flackwell Heath and RAF Daws Hill. Follow this road (watch out for the speed camera) over the motorway bridge and after about 2 miles turn left into Abbey Barn Lane, signposted with brown tourist signs. Continue down this road, under the motorway, and Wycombe Summit is on the left.
