### RACE FORMAT

Individual Slalom. The race will be the best total time from 2 runs on 2 different courses, the first run will be in reverse Snowsport England seed point order with the top 15 racers drawn. Racers without Snowsport England points will go before those who have points. Females will race first followed by the males. The second run will be in reverse time order.

### DUAL SLALOM

16 teams of 5 racers can enter the dual slalom on a first come first serve basis. Entries must be made on the day. Teams must have at least one racer of the opposite sex.

## RACE RULES

All racers are required to wear a helmet, gloves, long sleeves that also cover the midriff and long trousers at all times whilst on the slope, including open practice, course inspection and during the race. Ski poles must be fitted with bungs that increase the tip diameter to 15mm.

## RACE ENTRIES

The fee for the race is £25.00. All entries must be received by Thursday 13th October. This is to ensure sufficient time for pre-race organisation and preparation of start lists etc. Entries can be made to the race secretary via post, email or telephone, where possible the entry fee will accompany it. ## PRIZES

Medals will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each age group and overall for males and females. There will also be trophies for the overall winners male and female.

There will be prizes for the fastest male and female racers that are still of school age (racers born September 1987 or later) in the form of 1 week training bursaries from the newly set up British Alpine Race Academy (**BARA**) based in Radstadt, Austria. This is a new race academy set up by John O'Neill with top Austrian coaches and great training facilities.
