### Organisation

The event is being organised by Wycombe Phoenix Club on behalf of Snowsport England. To comply with Health & Safety within Gosling Ski Slope NO PERSONAL COOKING EQUIPMENT OR BBQs will be allowed. **CLEAR LUBRICANT ONLY NO YELLOW / BLUE CABLE PULLING LUBRICANT ALLOWED - THIS WILL BE ENFORCED**

Access to the car park will be from 7.30am

### Entry Criteria

The Club National event is a special slalom of 3 runs down the same course, and is open to registered racers in the following categories: Children I, Children II, Junior I, Junior II, Senior and Masters. Racers with no seed points are given priority over those with seed points. The Minis race follows the same format, and is open to registered racers born in 1997-2000. If the race entry does not reach 180 registered racers then non registered racers may enter the race provided an extra fee of £5.00 is paid to cover the cost of insurance i.e. total entry cost £21.00.

### Acceptance

Minutes of the first jury meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> May 2007. Valid entries were received from 112 racers ( 6 Girls, 10 Boys, 37 Females and 59 Males). All valid entries were accepted.

As the race is under subscribed at this time the jury decided to produce an acceptance list, the start list will be drawn using Seed List 2007.2 at the next jury meeting and displayed on the official notice board on the morning of the race.

Entries from racers with a note by their name on the enclosed acceptance list were provisionally accepted; but must see the Race Secretary on race day to validate their entry prior to collecting their bib. Notes are as follows:

S requires the entry form to be signed.

P requires payment / payment adjustment of £16.00 race entry fee.

R requires proof of registration

### Late entries

The jury will consider all late entries (up to a maximum of 180 racers) received by 10am on 8<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2007. THERE IS NO LATE ENTRY FEE

### Commentator sheets and race bibs

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the final run, and failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib.

### Referee's Report Protests

Referee's Report protests must be made in writing on official forms, which will be available at the race office. These must be completed and handed in within the set time limit, and accompanied by a fee of £25.

### Photography

Racers who do not wish to be photographed by any accredited photographer must notify the race secretary in writing by the end of racer registration on the day of the race. Any parents wishing to take photographs **MUST** report to the race office prior to doing so.

### First Aid

St Johns Ambulance personnel will be in attendance throughout the day

### Regulations / Race Rules

The race will be run in accordance to BACR (British Artificial Competition Rules) and under FIS rules as varied by Snowsport England. The last run will be in reverse time order based on the best time from the first two runs. The result will be based on the best time from the first two runs plus the time from the third.

**HELMETS:** skiers wearing helmets that do not meet the 2007 Ski Helmet regulations revised version as published on [www.britski.org](http://www.britski.org) / [www.gbski.com](http://www.gbski.com) **will not be allowed to race or forerun.**

**Ski Poles:** Ski poles with a minimum tip diameter of less than 15mm must be fitted with rubber or plastic tip protectors to increase the tip diameter to at least 15mm with **no metal parts protruding.**

The Start Referee has the right to refuse a racer starting if the racer does not appear on time. The Start Referee will be instructed to work to FIS 613.6.

Racers will be required to wear a helmet, gloves, long trousers and a long sleeved garment, which also covers the midriff, to reduce the risk of injury, at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and during the race. Racing in crop tops is not acceptable

Racers are reminded of the following:

1. No skis no up lift and **NO JUMPING** on the lifts.
2. Bad Language - TD's have been instructed to apply the unsportsmanlike behavior rule to any racer using bad language. This will result in sanctions ultimately leading to bans for repeated offenders.
3. Ski Binding Heights, Children 50mm Max, Junior / Seniors 55mm Max.
4. Start Licenses may be checked.

6. Only Accredited Persons are permitted on the race area during the race

7. **Doping control** Competitors should note that the Dope Control Unit may arrive unannounced at any event and will have the co-operation of the organisers of this race. There have been a number of recent amendments to the Doping Control Regulations; these changes mainly affect two groups of competitors, those who suffer from **asthma** and taking **asthma medication** and those using insulin to treat **insulin dependent diabetes**. The result of these new regulations is that any competitor using these drugs must obtain certification in writing from the doctor prescribing them or from the team physician. A form on which to obtain the appropriate certification is available from the SSE Head Office. This certification must be completed in advance of competition and returned to the SSE Medical Advisor with a SAE for acknowledgement of Notification to be returned to you. All competitors should note that this notification is required annually.

### Refunds

Following acceptance into the race, refunds of £10 will only be given to racers on production of a medical certificate.

Please note these races can only run with sufficient race officials. If you are able to assist please contact the Chief of Race.
